

WHAT IS CLIMATE CHANGE?


Climate change is the long-term temperature increases and shifting weather patterns observed across the planet.



The Earth has already warmed 1.8°F (1.0°C) on average since the mid-1800s. The 9 hottest years on record have been in the last two decades.






WHAT CAUSES CLIMATE CHANGE?

Human activities, including driving gas-powered cars, heating buildings with gas and oil, using fossil fuels to generate electricity, agriculture, and cutting down forests, create **greenhouse gases** that blanket the Earth and trap heat, warming the planet.
